2025-26 SAMRU Fees	Motion: To set the SAMRU General & Operating fee for 2025/26 at \$99.18 per semester for full-time students and \$47.42 per semester for part-time students. Joseph/Ha Carried	<ul> <li>Two options were suggested: keep the fee at the same level, or decrease the fee. The options were discussed at length at the committee meeting last week.</li> </ul>

	Motion: To maintain the SAMRU Capital Campaign fee for 2025/26 at \$40.00 per semester for full-time students and \$24.00 per semester for part-time students; To maintain the SAMRU Scholarship fee for 2025/26 at \$3.00 per semester for both full-time and part-time students; and that in accordance with the decision of the Reflector Publication Society of Calgary board, the Reflector fees remain at \$7.25 for full-time students and to \$3.63 for part-time students. San Jose/Baldonado Carried	
	Motion: To set the SAMRU Health and Dental fee for 2025/26 at \$385 per semester for full-time students. Joseph/Hernandez Alarcon Carried Action: ED Walters will bring a briefing and recommendation on standardizing the health and dental fee approval (January 2025)	<ul> <li>Premium is set by the insurance provider.</li> <li>If the premium is higher than the fee, we will take the additional money from the H&amp;D reserve fund; if the premium is lower than the fees collected, then the overages are deposited into the H&amp;D reserve fund. We also make interest earnings from this reserve and that is used to offset premiums when needed.</li> <li>There was additional information and a recommendation provided by ED Walters.</li> <li>There was a discussion around setting a standard for determining this fee in the future, for example, increasing the fee to the current year premium plus CPI.</li> </ul>

Joseph/Hernandez Alarcon Carried	<ul> <li>The committees discussed bylaw amendments to align with current governor terms; these will be brought to the March 2025 AGM for consideration.</li> <li>There was a discussion on the post-secondary learning act provisions.</li> <li>There was a discussion around students who are elected for a two-year term but graduate after one year. It was noted that a change can be made in the bylaws to be brought forward in January for review.</li> </ul>
REC Performance Evaluation Work Group	Motion: To appoint the following governors to the REC Performance Evaluation Work Group: 1. Governor Joseph 2. Governor Khan 3. Governor San Jose Khan/Hernandez Alarcon Carried	<ul> <li>Discussion: <ul> <li>Required to be completed by the Board annually.</li> <li>Timing is about halfway through the term in order to provide feedback to REC members.</li> <li>Must be completed prior to the end of the REC applications at the end of January for individuals seeking re-election.</li> <li>REC members will complete a self-evaluation, which the work group will review. The work group will also review past REC meeting minutes and REC accountability reports.</li> <li>The work group will consist of 3 governors, a staff support, and the Speaker if needed. They also have the opportunity to interview REC members and the Executive Director if required.</li> <li>The work group brings a recommendation to the board to vote on.</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
